Fenelon Place Elevator Ride

Historic cable car. Also known as the Fourth Street Elevator, this funicular railway has been called "the world's steepest, shortest scenic railway." 296 feet in length, elevating passengers 189 feet from Fourth Street up to Fenelon Place. National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium

This Smithsonian affiliate features dynamic aquariums, hands on experiences, and opportunities to learn about one of the most famous rivers in the World. During the event, attendees will have a chance to see the animals that call the main channel of the upper Mississippi River home and see some of the animals that call the lower river home. Hands on exhibits allow attendees to create a flood, fly over the Mississippi River starting in Minnesota and ending in Louisiana. In the Rivers of Innovation wing, take a look at a Belt Driven Machine Shop from the early 1900's. Kids will enjoy the hand on opportunities in the Makers Space and even a few water features. And for attendees who are interested in the pop culture, the new Popnology exhibit will be something to explore.
